Board of Trustees (2) Term: 3 Years

These individuals will join five others to serve on the Board of Trustees, which has general charge of the Society's property, conducts its business, and controls its administration. The Board of Trustees is the governing body of the Society. Meetings are held regularly once a month. Trustees create policy, perform long range financial planning, help develop the FUSN budget, and possess strong leadership skills. Membership on the Board is an honor, a responsibility, a learning experience, and enjoyable!

Trustee of High School Age Term: 1 Year

This person has the same responsibilities as a Trustee. This position may be shared by two people.

Treasurer Term: 1 Year

The Treasurer writes the checks, keeps accurate account of all property, receipts, expenditures, and indebtedness of the Society. The Treasurer is a full voting member of the Operations Council.

Assistant Treasurer (2) Term: 1 Year

These people perform critical backup role in the Treasurer's absence.

Delegates to the Mass Bay District (3) Term: 1 Year

The Mass Bay District meets several times a year to consider denominational affairs and develop relationships among local UU societies. Delegates keep FUSN informed of developments and distribute District Link Newsletter to the FUSN community.

Board of Investment (1) Term: 1 Year

The Board of Investment holds, invests and reinvests all funds transferred to it by the Board of Trustees. It is the guardian of our endowment and is accountable to the Society for its actions. A report is prepared for each Annual Meeting.

Delegates to the UU Service Committee (3) Term: 1 Yr

The UUSC, the denominational equivalent of our Social Action Committee, advocates for minority rights and justice in the US and around the world. Projects designed to improve social conditions.

Operations Council (2) Term: 3 Years

Under the authority of the Board of Trustees and through the various policy documents of the Society, the Operations Council shall work in partnership with the staff, and generally oversees committees and operations. Members of the Operations Council may be re-elected.

Moderator Term: 1 Year

The Moderator presides at the Annual Meeting (and any special meetings of the Society) and appoints the Nominating Committee. He or she requires a good understanding of the workings of the Society and Robert's Rules of Order, as well as patience and the ability to remain calm and neutral.

Clerk Term: 1 Year

The Clerk attends all meetings of the Society and the Board of Trustees, "keeping a true record of the workings of the business there transacted."

Assistant Clerk/Clerk of Council Term: 1 Year

This person acts as Clerk in the Clerk's absence and also takes minutes at monthly meetings of the Operations Council.
